

GROW in Meetings: Lead meetings that develop leaders and full-time followers of Christ.

Goal - What is something you would like to change/add/accomplish during your meeting times that would help your group meetings better develop emerging leaders and full-time followers of Christ?

Example: Starting and ending on time.

Reality – Where are you now? Evaluate your current situation.

Example: The meeting time is 6:30-8 p.m., but people don't show up until 6:45 and we don't really start the study until 7, which pushes our ending time back to 8:15 or 8:30.

Obstacles / Options - What obstacles might keep you from reaching your goal? What are different options to achieving your goal?

Example: Obstacles: Not fully understanding the importance of time management and the impact this has on your members/meetings.

Options: Set clear meeting/group expectations for members.

Way Forward - What are some of the next steps? Who will carry out these next steps? And when? Will you “do” or will you “delegate”? Do you need / want input from staff?

Examples: Explain how expectations will help the group spur one another on towards God's purposes for our lives.
